









# Major Mail-Borne Threats

Every year thousands\* of businesses, governmental organizations, NGOs, and prominent individuals receive threats through the mail. These can take many forms including:

<b>Dangerous Items</b>   Needles, razor blades, guns, knives, and lithium ion batteries are just a few of the items that could hurt recipients or mail handlers.	<b>Explosives</b>   In just one 10-day period in 2018, 16 pipe bombs were mailed to prominent Democratic Party politicians and President Trump.	<b>Contraband</b>   Many companies have found illegal drugs being sent to employees through the USPS and internal mail.	<b>Powders</b>  Five people were killed by letters containing anthrax in 2001; since then white powder has been commonly used as a mail-borne threat.
<b>Liquids</b>  Acids, tear gas, and other liquids can cause havoc and injury if released in a workplace.	<b>Chemical</b>  Many chemicals used in industrial applications are dangerous and readily available for purchase and shipping by bad actors.	<b>Biological</b>  Biological threats include microorganisms, viruses, and toxins that can harm humans.	<b>Nuclear</b>  If radioactive materials were to be released in a workplace, they could seriously harm people and render the facility permanently unusable.

Sometimes these are combined, such as an explosive device with a chemical agent. More often than not these are hoaxes containing powders or liquids.

Traditional X-ray scanners (indicated with ) can only detect explosives, dangerous items, and contraband. MailSecur can detect all of these including hoaxes.
